

Declaration of Conformity REACH Regulation

The protection of the environment and people, as well as the safe handling of chemicals are the main subjects of the chemicals regulation REACH (Regulation 1907/2006/EC) for classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures.

REACH stands for the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals and has been in force since June 1st 2007. REACH is implemented by ECHA, the European Chemicals Agency in Helsinki (FI). By July 1st 2018, all substances and preparations are to be registered, reviewed and authorised - articles as such do not have to be registered.

Substances of very high concern are either on the candidate list for authorisation or present in Annex XIV of the Regulation and require authorisation or may be restricted from use. For substances on the candidate list, information obligations apply within the supply chain.

Stengel GmbH does not produce substances or preparations and therefore is not subject to registration as a downstream user.

We have consulted our suppliers about REACH and obtained confirmations about their compliance with REACH.

To date, we have no information that the materials we use contain substances of concern according to the current candidate list.
